

OUZOUD WATERFALLS

The magnificent Ouzoud waterfalls, where water springs from a height of 110 meters and spectacularly plunges into a basin of limestone rocks! It is one of the most beautiful sites in the Central High Atlas and the M'Goun Geopark. Surrounding the waterfall is lush nature, offering opportunities to visit springs,

gorges, zawiyas, caves, grain mills, and authentic Amazigh villages. A place for relaxation and rejuvenation, you can engage in various activities throughout the year according to your preferences. You can also hire accredited tourist guides to accompany you on your hikes and cultural and sports activities.



OUZOUD WATERFALL

At the bottom of the Ouzoud waterfall, colorful little boats will take you as close as possible to the falls. In the site you will be able to observe a community of Magots monkeys living in freedom. At the top of the waterfall, a stone's throw from the impressive chasm, are ancient grain mills, still in operation thanks to the water of the torrent. Experiences to be absolutely lived!

TANGHMELT VILLAGE

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Discover the village of Tanghmelt, the oldest in the area, which stands out for its local architecture and authentic way of life. Visit the community hammam, traditional mills, cooperatives, threshing floors...

If you come with your family, several activities can be carried out by the children. All activities can be adapted to your needs and the duration of your stay.

HIKING

The Ouzoud Waterfalls site offers various hiking possibilities, either in loop or starshaped routes. The trails are accessible to everyone. During your hikes, you will traverse olive valleys, lakes, and visit villages made of pisé (rammed earth). You can observe Magot monkeys and a diverse flora. An essential walk is the one you can take to discover or rediscover the Ouzoud Waterfalls. The trails are well maintained and enjoyable. You can choose to descend to the edge of the waterfall on the trails, take a boat ride to get closer to the immense waterfall, observe the Magot monkeys, have a cup of tea or enjoy a delicious tajine in the numerous cafes and restaurants overlooking the falls. If you feel like shopping, climb back up the stairs and let yourself be tempted by the multitude of small bazaars.

MULE TREKKING

Hiking on a donkey or mule around the waterfall is a unique Amazigh experience, easy and accessible to children. Lasting 1 to 5 hours, you can visit the natural habitat of the Magot monkeys, admire the adobe douars, share a glass of hot tea with the locals, and discover the Amazigh culture.



MOUNTAIN BIKING (MTB)

Mountain bike enthusiasts appreciate the many circuits possibilities offered around the waterfall which allow you to discover the landscape, biological, geological and cultural diversity. The tours offered cover distances of 5 to 40 km and durations of 3 to 5 hours. The mountain bike trails connect the Amazigh villages in adobe. You can stop there to quench your thirst and visit the villages. Mountain bikes available for organized stays, otherwise bring your mountain bike.



Historical Sites



ZAOUIAT TANAGHMELT



Zaouiat Tanaghmelt was built in the 7th century by Abou Imrane Moussa Ben Yaacoub Al Bouguemaz. Eight kilometers from the famous Ouzoud Falls, it is located in the village of Tanaghmelt with its unique architectural character, also called the "Mexican" village. Location: Village of Tanaghmelt.

Dive into the history of Amazigh tribes

TRADITIONAL HAMMAMS



This 5 centuries old traditional hammam has made Zaouiat Tanaghmelt famous. It offers its services free of charge to the village's inhabitants by following ancestral tribal customs and organization. A fine illustration of Amazigh solidarity! You can admire the building, visit the water heating installations and find out how the community organizes itself. Location: village of Tanaghmelt.

Geosites

For the curious and enthusiasts of geology



OUZOUD WATERFALLS

The spring waters upstream form the Oued Tissakht which flows in spectacular waterfalls over a drop of more than 110 m high. The rocky cirque framing this impressive waterfall is carved out of Middle Jurassic limestone (approx. 170 Ma), lined with limestone concretions called travertines. This rock results from the chemical precipitation of calcium carbonate, a process still active today. This Site of Biological and Ecological Interest (SBEI) offers diverse habitats for fauna (maggot monkeys, bats, etc.).



GORGES OUED EL ABID

The Gorges Oued El Abid with a depth of 400 to 600 meters have red and steep walls. They were dug by Oued el Abid, the main tributary of the Oum Errabia. Location: On the road to Ait Attab.



JEMAA IKARIOUNE CAVES

For amateurs, 2 km from the waterfall, you can admire the stalactites and stalagmites of these natural caves. Location: Mougrsafen.

Biological and Ecological Riches



SBEI OF OUZOUD

The waterfall area is located on the Ouzoud River, approximately 1.5 km from its main source. The waterfall's waters flow over a gently sloping limestone slab before cascading down in a three-tiered travertine formation. The vegetation is lush, especially downstream of the waterfall. A stunning and dynamic cedar forest surrounds the entire valley and extends to the south. A small population of monkeys thrives in the cedar forest, and there is a strong presence of birds, including birds of prey, throughout the site and the valley downstream of the wadi. The landscape quality of the site is exceptional.

For nature lovers and ecotourism enthusiasts



A Site of Biological and Ecological Interest is the term used for protected areas in Morocco.

A SBEI is a remarkable ecosystem, with a high concentration of rare or endangered endemic plant and/or animal species, or with a high biodiversity index.

Visit this solidarity space created to promote and market the region's local products. During the Moussem period you can visit a large souk and attend fantasia shows. Location : Ait Taguella. Date : July.



OUZOUD FESTIVAL

Many activities are organized each year during this festival. Location : Ouzoud Date : in summer.

SOUK

Souk Ihad and Souk Tlat Location: Ait Taguella -Tazroute Day: Sunday -Tuesday Hours: 6 am to 4 pm - 6 am to 3 pm.



GROCERY

Fruit and vegetable merchants, grocery stores, butchers, pharmacy, bakery, in the center of the village of Ouzoud.



CLIMATE

Maximum temperature 39° (July-August), minimum 2° (December to February).

ROADS

The majority of the main roads are paved.

FUEL

Gas stations in Ouzoud. Contact your accommodation in the event of a breakdown so as to be put you in touch with a mechanic.

TRANSPORTATION

Grand taxi between Azilal and Ouzoud. Journey time 50 minutes for about 20 Dhs. Large taxi between Marrakech and Ouzoud. Duration of the trip 2 hours and a half for about 100 Dhs.

DANGERS AND INCONVENIENCE 🗽

Very safe rural communities. In case of heavy rains in the mountains, some small risk of flooding. In winter the road can be cut off by snow for a few hours. Do not go into the mountains without a licensed guide who knows the area.

PHARMACY AND EMERGENCIES

Pharmacy in Ouzoud. Public and private hospitals in Demnate and Azilal.

MONEY

Ticket office banking in Azilal, some accommodations only accept cash.

PHONE AND INTERNET

All telephone operators have a network operating in the valley.

LANGUES

The predominant language in the region is Tamazight followed by dialectal Arabic. Most accommodation owners and all guides are fluent in at least French and English.

M'GOUN UNESCO GEOPARK

The M'Goun UNESCO Geopark is the first Geopark in Morocco, Africa and the Arab world. This protected territory includes a large number of geosites of exceptional interest and many places of high ecological, archaeological, historical and cultural value. There are notably remarkable footprints of sauropod and theropod dinosaurs as well as numerous deposits of dinosaur bones.

Located in the Central High Atlas between Beni Mellal in the north and the crest line of Ighil M'Goun in the south, the M'Goun Geopark covers an area of approximately 5700 km² and includes 15 municipalities : Azilal, Demnate Tilouguite Zawiat Ahansal Tabant Ait M'Hamed; Ait Taguella Agoudi N' Lkheir Ait Abbas; Ait Boulli; Ait Blal Sidi Boulkhelf Tifni Anergui and Boutferda.
